## I. CONSECRATION OF THE PRIESTHOOD

### A. THE CLEANSING OF THE PRIESTS

- **Chapter 29:1-3 - The Priesthood Of Aaron Was Initiated With Sacrifices.**

- Verse 4 - The washing with water. This is a picture of baptism.

- Matthew 3:14-15 - *And John tried to prevent Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me?" But Jesus answered and said to him, "Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness."*

- Verse 7 - The Priests were then Anointed with Oil.

- **Verses 38-42 - The Two Lambs Offered Continuously.**

- The 2 Lambs are called the *tamid* offering. *Tamid* means 'continual.'

- Verse 42 - Note: The word "burnt offering" is "olah" or a "holocaust (as going up in smoke)

- **Chapter 30:18 - The Laver For Washing.**

- John 13:10 - *Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean..."*

- Psalm 24:3-4 - *Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? Or who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart...*

- **Verse 25 - The Oil Of Gladness!**

- Hebrews 1:8-9

- **Verse 35 - The Golden Altar Of Incense.**

- Revelation 8:3-4 - *Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand.*

## B. THE PURPOSE OF PRAYER AND FASTING
