- Let Us \_\_\_\_\_ For The King Is Come! - verses 1-2

- Isaiah 40:9 - *Get yourself up on a high mountain, O Zion, bearer of good news, Lift up your voice mightily, O Jerusalem, bearer of good news; Lift it up, do not fear. Say to the cities of Judah, "Here is your God!"*

- John's preaching centered on *Repentance* and the *Kingdom of Heaven*. The word 'repent' means to change one's mind and then change one's behavior.

- verses 3-4

- 1 John 3:8 - *For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy (destroy, loosen, and dissolve) the works of the devil.*

- Isaiah 35:4-6 - *Say to those who are fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! Behold, your God will come with vengeance, with the recompense of God; He will come and save you." Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped. Then the lame shall leap like a deer, and the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, and streams in the desert.*
